Qualification Scope

Transcend Activitie Level 2 Award in Leading is a vocationally related qualification that sits in sector subject area 08.1 Sport, leisure, and recreation. This is a specialist pathway qualification which must be delivered in the context of one of the pathways. It is relevant to 14-19-year-old learners in full time education, young adults and adults who wish to be employed as an activity leader in one of the following technical areas.

- Inclusive Physical Activities
- Inclusive Martial Arts Activities

Successful learners may wish to use this qualification progress onto an industry standard coaching qualification with the view to commencing a career as a school, club or community coach in one of the technical areas.

Qualification purpose	The qualification purpose is to confirm occupational competence. The qualification sub-purpose is to confirm the ability to meet legal requirements made by the professional body.				
Qualification rationale	The rationale for the development, delivery and awarding of this qualification is to support the professionalisation and subsequent transformation of the physical activity leadership and sports coaching workforce. The intent is to enable industry employers in active leisure environments to use the qualification as a minimum operating standard and a pre-requisite for employees to achieve before registering onto an industry standard coaching qualification.				
Qualification aim	The aim of the qualification is to develop each learner's ability to lead safe and engaging activity sessions in the context of the specialist pathway.				
Qualification objective	The objective of the qualification is to provide a benefit to learners by supporting a voluntary or paid role as an activity leader in a school, community or commercial leisure environment. Whilst attending the qualification learners will develop the knowledge and skills required to be able to: • fulfil duties associated with leading inclusive activities in the context of a specialist pathway • drive engagement through inclusive activities in the context of a specialist pathway • meet the deployment expectations when leading physical activities in the context of a specialist pathway				
Qualification uniqueness	This qualification is unique as it is the only physical activity leadership qualification which focuses on inclusive practice in the active leisure environment. The Register of Regulated Qualifications should be accessed to source information on other awarding organisation providers who offer similar provision.				



Qualification Structure

This qualification must be achieved in the context of a specialist pathway. The structure of each endorsed pathway is comprised of three mandatory units. Two mandatory core units that focus on the leadership role. One mandatory pathway unit selected from one of the optional pathways that focus on the technical competencies.

Learners must successfully complete 3 mandatory units to be awarded the qualification certificate. The qualification certificate will confirm the title of the qualification in the specialist pathway as follows:
