Qualification Scope

The Transcend Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training is an Ofqual regulated occupational qualification. Developed in collaboration with the British Training Board [BTB], It is delivered by military trainers licenced by the BTB and is awarded by Transcend.

This qualification is designed to enable members of the armed forces, veterans and other public servants 19+ who wish to develop advanced teaching skills for further education (FE), vocational training, or adult education settings. The aim of this qualification is to develop the learner's ability to design, deliver, and evaluate educational programmes through advanced theoretical and practical approaches that will enable them to GAIN and RETAIN employment as educators.

Qualification uniqueness

This is the only qualification developed specifically for military professionals and veterans to translate their skills into the civilian role of a Further Education Tutor and Assessor. The <u>Register of Regulated Qualifications</u> provides information on other awarding organisation providers who offer similar provision.



Qualification rationale

Across Great Britain, 2.03 million people reported that they had previously served in the UK armed forces (76% in the regular forces, 20% in the reserve forces and 4% in both). This represents 3.8% (almost 1 in 25) of the total population aged 16 or over. Overall, 7.0% of households in Great Britain included one or more veterans. To enable veterans to thrive in their transition into civilian life they need to demonstrate occupational competence in civilian roles.
